Families in remote villages of Guatemala have limited education opportunities. They have unreliable/no access to the internet.






Many who have quality internet connections believe that the majority of people in remote areas are connected to the internet.




Unlocking Learning Potential with Technology



Initial Launch - 2024

- Over 200 Illiterate adult students
- 5 remote villages
- Students are learning to read and write in their native language






Classes

- Students meet as a class but work at their own pace
- A teacher can be present to assist
- Students encourage each other and often work together

Technology: A New Experience

- Students are introduced to technology they have not previously used
- Learning to use technology exposes them to national and global information





StudiaOne Remote Learning Platform

Active learning model

- Students can learn concepts at their own pace
- Mentor/teacher has tools to view students who require assistance

Support for no internet

- Works when there is unreliable internet, or when it is too costly Sync with a USB drive so data flows between student and teacher (when

- - students have no connectivity)






Support for indigenous languages

- Students learn more effectively in their native language




Student Experience






Dashboard Filters
